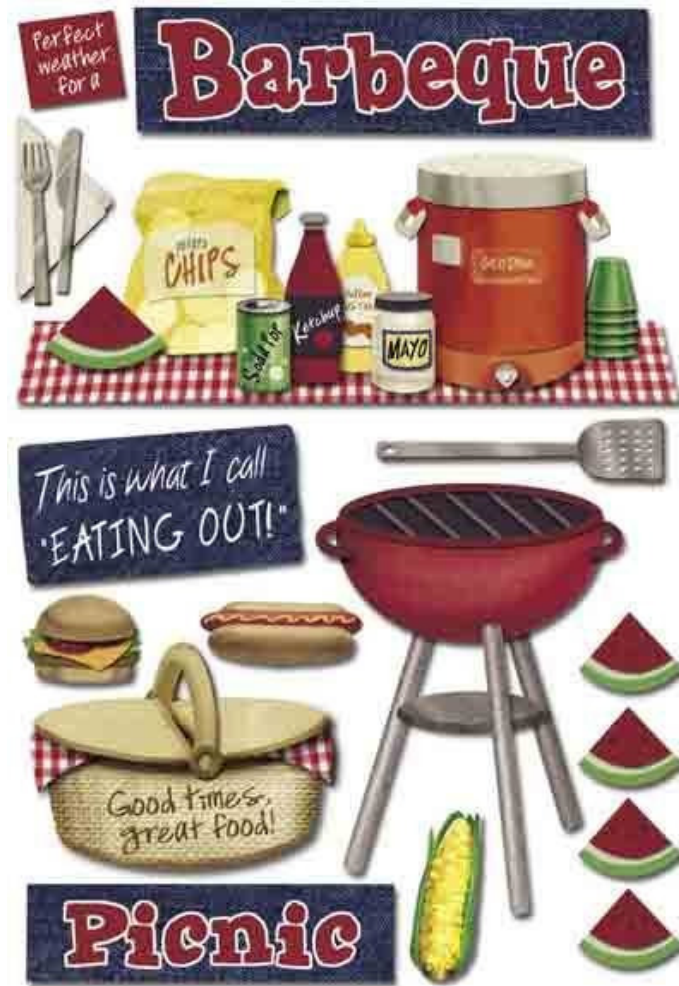

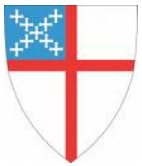

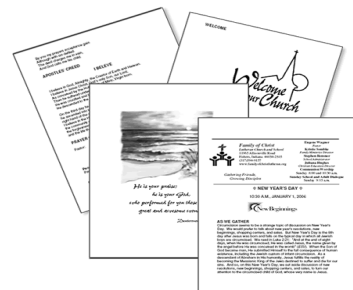

## WISE SAYINGS

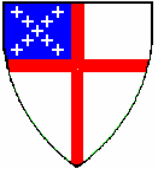
Are these wise sayings from the Bible or from somewhere else?
